WHAT ARE YOUTH BUCKS?

Youth Bucks will be earned for serving outside of regular church functions. (babysitting for life groups, service projects like raking leaves, mowing lawns, helping move, etc.) These Youth Bucks can be used towards any events, camps, or trips we take as a youth group.

HOW WILL STUDENTS HEAR ABOUT SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES?

Students will sign up to be a part of the Youth Bucks program. They will be entered into a GroupMe chat where they can receive information about each service opportunity. It will be first come first serve on who signs up for the service opportunity.

HOW DO STUDENTS SIGN UP TO BE IN THE YOUTH BUCKS PROGRAM?

Students should contact Emerson Bandemer, JC Pappan, or Mackenzie Mynhier to receive an application.

HOW MUCH CAN THEY EARN FOR EACH TIME THEY SERVE?

Students will earn a different amount per service project. The amount of pay for youth bucks will be communicated in the job description.

CAN PEOPLE DONATE TO THE YOUTH BUCKS FUND?

Yes, you can donate the the Youth Bucks fund, but all donations go directly to the general fund and not to a specific student.

WILL WE NEED BACKGROUND CHECKS IF THEY ARE SERVING FOR CHILD CARE?

Students above 18 years old will need a background check if they will be serving for child care. Background checks are not required for minors or for anyone serving outside of child care.
